1. Mountain Ranges: The major mountain ranges in the United States are the Appalachian Mountains, the Rocky Mountains, the Alaska Range, the Cascades, and the Sierra Nevada. The ranges are further divided into smaller sub-ranges and ridges. The tallest mountain peak in the United States is Mount McKinley in the Alaska Range, which stands 20,320 feet above sea level. Label the mountain ranges on your map.
